你常看方向盤下面的里程數,但你算不算你吃的大白菜的「里程」?

「食物里程」、指的是食物在我們嘴巴和原產地之間的距離。里程高、表示食物經過了漫長的運送過程、 一路上交通工具所消耗的汽油,和隨之而生的二氧化碳,破壞了環境。

「食物里程」要低,大家要盡量吃「本地生產」的食物。夏天的芒果,台灣最好,很少人會去吃進口芒 果。會買進口水果,是因為想吃當季台灣沒有的東西。所以要減少「食物里程」,首先要吃「當季」的東西。 當季的食物新鮮、便宜,何苦違背自然,去吃大老遠跑來的祭品?

當季和當地,除了新鮮和少污染,另一個好處是活絡了本地經濟,改良了都市與農村的關係。「愛台灣」 不用上街頭,在家裡吃本地食物就可以。

在美國,許多學校發起「農場直達餐廳」運動。讓學校的午餐,不再是大量製造的冷凍食品,而是鄰近 農場送來的鮮美佳餚。

我們也許沒去過美國的學校,但在美國各大城,應該都逛過「農家市場」(Farmers' Markets,最有名的 在 L.A., 1934 年開張)。食物由當地的農家直接拿到市集來賣,不再大費周章地送到經銷商的中央倉庫。

如今,美國各地都有類似的市場。西北部的奧勒岡州講究環保,大城波特蘭有一家「新季節」(「New Seasons」)超市,所有的肉和蔬果都標明原產地,27%是當地生產。為了鼓勵民眾購買,當地產品都貼上黃 色標籤。「新季節」甚至把一些瀕臨絕種的食物,如紅鯛魚,貼上紅色標籤,勸消費者不要購買。甚至讓消 費者免費試吃不同魚類,證明黃標和紅標一樣鮮美。

樂活的店家,會阻止消費者買他的東西。樂活的人,應該婉拒瀕臨絕種的魚。讀萬卷書,不如行萬里路。 行萬里路,不如認識你的鄰居。
