四、閱讀測驗【請依照段落上下文意，選出最適當的答案】

For most fans, the excitement of a live football match is a mix of sights and sounds: the referee's whistle, the thud of the ball, and the deafening roar of the crowd when a goal is scored. However, for the 430 million people worldwide with disabling hearing loss, this acoustic atmosphere has always been inaccessible. Until now.

A new technology called "haptic jerseys" is changing how deaf and hard-of-hearing fans experience live sports. Developed by a team of engineers in Newcastle, these shirts use sensors and small motors woven into the fabric. Microphones placed around the stadium capture real-time noises, such as chanting fans or the ball hitting the crossbar. These sounds are then converted into vibrations that the fan feels on their skin. A sharp, quick buzz might represent a whistle, while a rolling, deep vibration mimics the crowd cheering. "It is about inclusion," says lead developer Dr. Sarah Jenkins. "We aren't just translating sound; we are translating emotion. When the crowd goes wild, the shirt pulses with energy. It allows deaf fans to feel the shared adrenaline of the moment."

The technology was recently tested at a Premier League match. Participants described the experience as transformative. One fan, who has been deaf since birth, said he finally understood why hearing people jump out of their seats during a close game. He could physically feel the tension building in the stadium.

While the technology is currently expensive to produce, the goal is to make it standard equipment in stadiums within five years. Critics argue that the cost might limit who can use it, but developers are working with sponsors to lower the price. They believe that eventually, these shirts will be as common as buying a team scarf, ensuring that the "sound" of victory is something everyone can share.

第二題：【英翻中】

Meta is reportedly weighing layoffs that could impact at least 20% of its workforce as the tech giant looks to offset rising artificial intelligence costs. The cuts come as the technology company aims to offset the cost of artificial intelligence infrastructure and prepare for greater efficiency brought about by AI-assisted workers, three sources familiar with the matter told Reuters. The outlet added that the timing and size of the potential layoffs have not been finalized. When reached for comment, a Meta spokesperson told FOX Business, "This is just a speculative report."
